# WINEMAKER:

Marcio Ramírez.

### VARIETY:

Cabernet Sauvignon 90%, Carmenere 10%.

## ORIGIN:

Palo Santo Vineyard South bank of the Tinguiririca River D.O. Marchigue Colchagua Valley.

### SOIL:

Loam, good drainage, colluvial terraces with gentle slopes of granitic origin due to deposits of matter carried by the Tinguiririca River.

### CLIMATE:

Sub-humid Mediterranean. Free of temperature extremes, moderated by the influence of the Tinguiririca River and coastal breezes.

### HARVEST:

April 2009

## AGING:

14 months in French and American oak, medium-toast barrels.

### TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep red

Nose: Intense aromas of black fruits, plums, cherries, chocolate, and cassis Palate: Concentrated, with sweet tannins. Red fruit flavors. Good structure and density.
