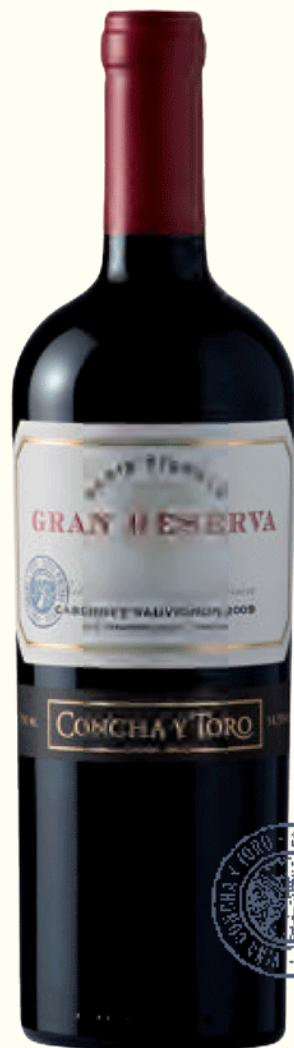

WINEMAKER:

Marcio Ramírez.

VARIETY:

Cabernet Sauvignon 90%, Carmenere 10%.

ORIGIN:

*Palo Santo Vineyard
 South bank of the Tinguiririca River
 D.O. Marchigüe
 Colchagua Valley.*

SOIL:

Loam, good drainage, colluvial terraces with gentle slopes of granitic origin due to deposits of matter carried by the Tinguiririca River.

CLIMATE:

Sub-humid Mediterranean. Free of temperature extremes, moderated by the influence of the Tinguiririca River and coastal breezes.

HARVEST:

April 2009

AGING:

14 months in French and American oak, medium-toast barrels.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep red

Nose: Intense aromas of black fruits, plums, cherries, chocolate, and cassia

Palate: Concentrated, with sweet tannins. Red fruit flavors. Good structure and density.
