The Tierra de Luna red is a blend of Syrah (80 percent) and Malbec (20 percent) in the softer Aussie Shiraz style rather than the peppery French Syrah style. This is a soft red, light-bodied but with enough acidity to make it a good pairing with food. We perceived hints of tobacco smoke and blackberries on the nose. After sampling, Sean mentioned cooked tomatoes with herbs, or a smoked tomato marinara, which described the flavors very well. On the tart finish there was hint of mineral or even rust, to give it a subtle sanguine character. A simple wine for easy quaffing that works for your softer red friends who like Merlot or pinot noir. It pairs perfectly with barbecue, hamburgers and pizza.
