Tasting Notes	This is a delicious and velvety Carmenera that is characteristic of its variety. Red fruit aromas of strawberries and raspberries combine with spicy notes. In the mouth it is structured and juicy with fruity notes and a nicely balanced acidity. Drink young: 2 to 3 years.
