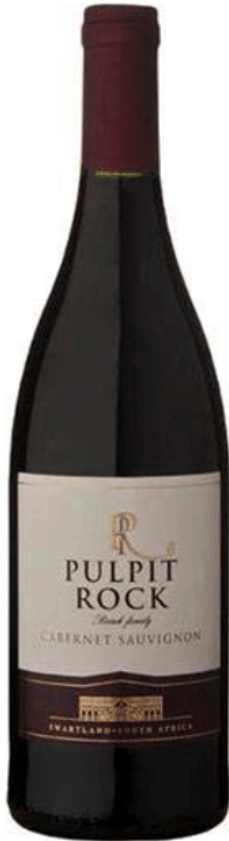


Pulpit Rock Brink Family Cabernet Sauvignon 2011

tasting notes

Deep red color with very intense violet reflections. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a vanilla and chocolate touch. Mouth feel shows good volume and round, sweet, persistent tannins.

Fermentation occurred in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature (25-28 °C) with two daily pump-overs extracting color and tannins. After natural malolactic fermentation completed the wine matured 14 months in French and American oak barrels.
