Made by Granadeiro, a high quality producer, Tapada Dos is a delicious blend of Aragonez (Tempranillo), Trincadeira, Alicante Bouchet and Syrah.

Flavor Profile: Fuller-bodied, dry. Red berry fruit on the nose with notes of vanilla and oak. The palate is filled with concentrated ripe berries before finishing with soft tannins and bright acids. Pair with spicy chickpea stew, roasted lamb dressed with garlic & herb, and grilled sausages with onions & peppers.
