## 2007 VINTAGE TASTING NOTES

Picture perfect until late August, the 2007 vintage posed an unusual challenge, will heat spell in September followed by rains and the threat of frost. Selective harvest (the majority at night) produced a vintage recalling the generous 2001, with aromatic cassis, nutmeg, raspberries, cola, fresh oats, dark chocolate and forest floor. Polished, supple and harmoniously precise, the 2007 fuses a seamless mid-palate with soft yet sinewy tannins. The wine will age effortlessly for decades.
