Variedad | 85 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 10 % Malbec, 5 % Cabernet Franc.

Viñedos | Cabernet Sauvignon: Agrelo (Luján de Cuyo), Altamira (San Carlos), Los Árboles (Tunuyán). Malbec: Ugarteche (Luján de Cuyo). Cabernet Franc: Agrelo.

Fermentación | Selección manual de granos, despalillado, estrujado suave, levadura seleccionada. Remontajes y délestages tres veces diarias. Máxima temperatura 28° C. Maceración extendida 20 días.

Alcohol | 13,9 % vol

Acidez | 5,19 g/l

Raíces | Pie franco

Elevación del Viñedo (msnm) | Cabernet Sauvignon 1.140 (3.740 pies). Malbec 900 (2.950 pies) y Cabernet Franc 980 (3.210 pies).

Método de Cosecha | Manual

Estadía en Barriles | 11 meses 50 % roble francés nuevo y 50 % roble americano de segundo uso.

Guarda en botella | Hasta 10 - 15 años.

"Good deep red-ruby color. Aromas and flavors of blackberry, violet and licorice. Silky and lush in texture, with enticing spice character giving added freshness to the wine's strong fruit. Finishes with sweet tannins. "

"Good bright red. Aromatic nose offers redcurrant, tobacco and nutty oak. Supple, spicy and fine-grained, with moderate complexity and enticing sweetness to the currant and tobacco flavors. Finishes with firm but sweet tannins."

"Owner Pedro Marchevsky, the husband of Susana Balbo, is a renowned viticulturalist in Mendoza. The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon (which contains 10% Malbec) spent 10 months in 50% new French oak and 50% 1 year American oak. Deep crimson-colored, it has an attractive bouquet of cedar, coffee, cassis, and black currants. This leads to a medium-bodied, fruit-driven wine with light-tannin, silky fruit and good length."
