APELLATION: La Consulta and Vista Flores, Uco Valley, Mendoza.

VARIETALS: 39% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Malbec, 23% Syrah, 8% Petit

Verdot and 6% Cabernet Franc.

VINTAGE: 2011

YIELD PER HECTARE: 5,120 kg/ha. HARVEST: Manual. First half of April.

BOTTLES PRODUCED: 16,000 FILTRATION: Without filtration.

AGEING: 14 months in French oak barriques.

ALCOHOL: 14.5 % by vol.

VINES PER HECTARE AND YEAR PLANTED: La Consulta old vines was planted 1947 and 1962, 4,200 plants per hectare. Vista Flores was planted 2007, 3,628 plants per hectare.

SOILS AND ELEVATION: 3,500 feet. La Consulta is predominantely clay. Vista Flores is a combination of rocky, sand, and clay soils.

## WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES:

Garnet in color, the nose is extremely fragrant with violet, and red and blue fruits. In the mouth, the wine shows many layers of red and blue fruit, dried fruits, violet, vanilla, and tobacco. Having a very good structure and soft tannins, the finish is long and elegant. May be consumed now or laid down for 8-10 years.
