La Consulta is predominantly clay; La Consulta Altamira Vineyard is clay and sand; Vista Flores is a combination of rocky, sand, and clay soils WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES This wine shows very good color depth, with outstanding red and violet nuances, characteristic of Malbec. It amuses us with complex aromas of sweet red fruits and floral fragrances like violets, typical of Malbec. The oak provided delicate whiffs of vanilla and tobacco with a hint of white chocolate that complete the aromatic richness. The first in-mouth sensation comes from the sweetness with soft ripe tannins. The texture and structure are worthy of this variety.
