Tasting notes:

A dry red wine. Vigorous and well balanced in flavours, this wine reveals aromas of prunes and black cherries. The taste is dominated by raspberry, vanilla and spices notes, showing excellent depth of flavour.
A medium to full bodied wine contributed to the fine, long tannins

Ideal with beef, lamb and pork dishes, grilled vegetables and cheeses
