Lurton

Jacques & Francois Lurton originate from Bordeaux and became two of the most respected flying winemakers in the world. They started producing wine in Argentina in 1992 in Mendoza in the foothills of the Andes at altitudes of 450 - 1200m above sea level where the temperature is cooler and the grapes ripen slower.

Tasting

Pale straw in colour, the nose is quite aromatic and peachy. The palate offers a lovely silky texture with good acidity and quite a full body with flavours of citrus and peaches. The wine is smooth and rounded and perfect on its own or with food.
