Kerem Montefiore is a small winery founded to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Mishkenot Sha'ananim, founded by Moses Montefiore, which became the cornerstone of modern Jerusalem. The winery is joint venture between Arnon Geva (ex Castel, Carmel & Yatir) and the first Israeli Montefiores. The winery was inspired by Moses Montefiore's agricultural vision, his love for wine and his passion for Jerusalem.

VINIFICATION:	Harvested early, cold fermented in stainless steel.
AGEING:	Unoaked
ALCOHOL:	12.5%
RS:	Dry
WINE DESCRIPTION:	Tropical fruit aroma, with a refreshing hint of lime. Good acidity makes a refreshing finish.
FOOD PAIRING:	Fish, chicken & as an aperitif



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
