## **MONTEFIORE WINERY**

Kerem Montefiore is a small winery founded to celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Mishkenot Sha'ananim, founded by Moses Montefiore, which became the cornerstone of modern Jerusalem. The winery is joint venture between Arnon Geva (ex Castel, Carmel & Yatir) and the first Israeli Montefiores. The winery was inspired by Moses Montefiore's agricultural vision, his love for wine and his passion for Jerusalem.

WINE: Montefiore Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

**VARIETIES:** 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Petit Verdot

WINE REGIONS: Judean Hills

**SOIL:** Limestone

CLIMATE: Mediterranean

WINEMAKER: Sam Soroka, winemaking consultant.

VINIFICATION: Part oak aged (50%), part stainless steel (50%)

**AGEING:** Aged for 8 months mainly in American oak.

ALCOHOL: 13%

**WINE DESCRIPTION:** Full flavored with a cherry berry nose, a

backdrop of vanilla and a well-balanced finish.

FOOD PAIRING: Kebab, hamburger or roast chicken

**PRODUCTION:** 50,000 bottles (total production).



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
