Estate grown grapes - produced and bottled on the Estate

The grapes were grown in Joubert's own vineyards in the celebrated region of Paarl. After fermentation for 7 days in stainless steel, the wine was transferred to French oak barriques for 12 months.

A smooth wine with a nose of violets, plums, and spice flavours. The palate is attractive, well rounded and mature; full of dark stone fruit flavours, with softened oak tannins giving good structure. A reasonably powerful wine which demands a good hearty roast.

This is one of the very best South African Merlot wines - full and flavoursome.

Note that this wine is no longer imported into the UK and when gone cannot be repeated.

The last available vintage is the superb 2014. Great value at Binendwines' price of just £8.50.
