The wines of Fronsac were once as famous as the Médoc, with the hillier vineyards of Canon-Fronsac renowned for producing the best wines. With increasing investment from some of Bordeaux's top producers, like JP Moueix and Château Lafleur, this is an appellation back on the up.

- Château du Gazin has been in the Robert family since 1933 and benefits from well-drained, hillside vineyards with excellent southern exposure
- It's a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon from vines with an average age of over 40 years
- Then of course, there's the vintage 2015 was a tremendous year in Bordeaux and this shows the vibrant, rich fruit typical of this great year

Tasting note:A deep, rich colour with a medley of juicy, soft, dark fruits on the nose – black cherries, blueberries and plums. Very rich and rounded on the palate with generous, ripe fruit that characterises this vintage balanced by a hint of toasty oak from barrel ageing and a full, long finish.
