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

Today, "Familia Barberis" Malbec is a highly sought-after wine in Argentina, and you're about to find out why. The grapes to craft the wine came from some of the region's top vineyards, and then blended to perfection. It's a dream come true in a wine glass.

A midseason ripener, it can bring very deep color, ample tannin, and a particular plum-like flavor component to add complexity to claret blends.
