Sweet 1 2 3 4 5 Dry Light 1 2 3 4 5 Full bodied

Colour

Medium to deep purple/red with light purple hues

Bouquet

Rich ripe blackcurrant and plum nuances with hints of red cherry and red fruit lift.

Palate

Blackcurrants and cherry supported by the softness / sweetness of the perfectly integrated oak coupled with the delicacy of an enjoyable acid structure allowing the wine to finish smoothly with lingering tannins.

Roast chicken with lemon.
