Community Tasting History

Community Tasting Notes *(average 87 pts. and median of 87 pts. in 1 note)*

Tasted by Timbalimba on 4/29/2011 & rated 87 points: Purple red. All youth. Raspberry and blueberry grab the attention, some toasted oak. No signs of violets or the "sour milk" of Mendoza. Palate is overtly fruity, flashy, but not silly. Decently long aftertaste with soft tannins and moderate acidity. Good value. Drink now - 2013.

Again, a fascinating contrast to their siblings in Mendoza, the Neuquén wines I have tried have all been cooler, less fragrant, and rather original in their expressions of grape variety.
